Old Business:

It was brought up to move \$10,000 from the checking into this account to gain more money in interest. That keeps around \$15,000 in the original checking account for use. Daniel Matthews made a motion to open that new account, Jason Robertson seconded.

- Regarding the gas tank:

Ryan talked to GMB energy. They have 500 gallon gas tanks and 1000 gallon gas tanks. If you use at least 400 of the 500 gallon tank, the \$225 lease fee is waived. If you use at least 800 of the 1000 gallon tank, the \$325 lease fee is waived. You pay the lease fee if you do not use at least that much. We are waiting on another quote from quality oil to vote and make a decision and then we will vote by email.

- It was brought up to look at the cost of propane by Colt. Last year it was \$2.69, which made the bill \$180-\$190 every month. The thermostat was being kept at 55 degrees and the pipes froze 4-5 times this past year, according to Shuskey. We decided the thermostat should be set to 62-65 degrees. Thinking about getting a new thermostat you can change the temperature with your phone. Ryan made the motion to buy a thermostat for \$150 or less, Daniel seconded the motion.
