Old Business:

- Fundraiser: Shop with a Cop
 - We have sold 850 tickets, with 150 unsold/lost tickets.
 - There were two options: (1) reprint the tickets we are missing after going through all of the stubs and sell them at a discounted price to get them all sold, or (2) cut our losses and just not sell those tickets and hope that those numbers come up as winning lottery numbers so we don't have to buy those guns and we are saving money rather than losing it.
 - Option 2 was chosen. It was decided that the tickets we do know where they are, we decided to just continue to sell at \$20 a piece and just let go of the lost or forgotten tickets.
 - There is still no definite number of kids that will be chosen, still waiting to hear from SRO's. So far, we have around 15 volunteers.

New Business:

- New members: Blake Weavil
 - Joe Crotts made a motion to accept, Mike Foster seconded motion. Motion carried.
- The vacuum broke, Haynes said he would bring their extra one for the time being
- The hot water heater is being replaced, it will be around \$3,000-3,500.00.
- Money was brought up when we said how much was in the accounts. The Sheriff's Office gives us \$10,000 a year split up quarterly (\$2,500 per quarter) and we have \$17,800 now. It was brought up that the roof is old and needs replaced, but we have had two quotes regarding the roof and both companies said it is fine and we have another 10 years on this roof, at least. So no, the roof does not need to be replaced.
- When the toilet is flushed in the men's room, you must make sure to put the handle up. It keeps running. Haynes said he would replace the flapper or the handle on the toilet to repair it for the time being.

- The front door has been left unlocked without the alarm being set. This needs to be addressed with who is doing it. Also, a lot of people use the back door when you need to use the front door. If you use the back door after you set the alarm, it'll set the alarm off.
- The password is rangemaster if you get locked out of the building from the alarm.
- The fence being down from the trees has been addressed. The tree guy came out and trimmed the trees and said nothing is wrong. It is just a constant argument.
- It was brought up to have the range mowed more consistently. They want to speak to Mathis and see if he will help with that or hire someone to come cut the grass more often. We said we would talk about it in the warmer months when it is needed, not now since it is winter.
